FRENCH (FRE)

FRE 101 Beginning French I (4 CR.)

Introduces cultural awareness, listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills and emphasizes basic French sentence structure. Classes may be conducted in target language. Part I of II. Lecture 4 hours per week. This is a UCGS transfer course.

FRE 102 Beginning French II (4 CR.)

Introduces cultural awareness, listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills and emphasizes basic French sentence structure. Classes may be conducted in target language. Part II of II. Lecture 4 hours per week. **Prerequisite(s)** FRE 101, or two years of successful completion of high school French, or demonstrated experiential learning, or by placement test, or equivalent

FRE 104 Basic Spoken French II (3 CR.)

Prerequisite is FRE 103. Teaches oral communication and introduces cultural mores and customs to students with no prior instruction in the language. Lecture 3 hours per week.

FRE 201 Intermediate French I (3 CR.)

Continues to develop cultural awareness, listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills, and introduces complex French sentence structures. Classes may be conducted in target language. Part I of II. Lecture 3 hours per week.

Prerequisite(s) FRE 102, or three years of successful completion of high school French, or demonstrated experiential learning, or by placement test, or equivalent

FRE 202 Intermediate French II (3 CR.)

Prerequisite(s) FRE 201, or four years of successful completion of high school French, or demonstrated experiential learning, or by placement test, or equivalent
